Where Does Africa Stand?



Only 1 in 4 parliamentarians in Africa is a woman.



Some bright spots:

- Rwanda: 61.3% women in parliament
- Senegal: Gender parity law since 2010
- South Africa: 46% women MPs

But many countries still lag far behind.

Sender bills are still facing challenges in Nigeria, Sierra Leone, and others.

- Q Representation gaps persist in leadership positions and committee roles.
- Many women still face barriers to entry: patriarchy, financing and harassment.
